Vaccine Requirements & Recommendation

Pets partaking in boarding and/or daycare are required to be current on Rabies, Distemper, and Parvo by Iowa Law. Bordetella is a requirement of our facility in order to reduce the likelihood of canine kennel cough and the Leptospirosis vaccine is highly recommended. Records must be on file by law before your pet enters the facility. Records can be emailed by your vet our yourself directly to pawsandplaymtown@gmail.com

Services Agreement

Highland Hollow LLC dba Paws & Play and its employees agree to provide services in a trustworthy manner. In consideration of these services and as an express condition thereof, the client expressly waives any and all claims against Highland Hollow LLC or its employees, unless arising from gross negligence on the part of Highland Hollow LLC.

Client understands and agrees that when utilizing boarding services:

- Payment is due when service(s) has been completed.
- All pets will be treated with routine flea preventative.
- All pets must have a veterinarian and be current on vaccinations. Current records must be on file prior to your pet's stay.
- All dogs must be accompanied by a leash.
- Pets infected with contagious disease will not be boarded.

If participating in group play the client also understands and agrees that dog group play is considered a privilege under lowa law and the following additional requirements apply:

- Dogs over six months of age must be spayed or neutered, and written documentation on file.
- Written documentation of medical history provided by veterinarian.
- Dogs will be subject to a pre-screening process to evaluate temperament prior to being allowed in group play. Dogs shown to be aggressive will not be allowed to participate in group play.

Dogs authorized to participate in group play/enrichment do interact with other dogs and employees. The client must express any known aggression problems that the dog has had with other animals or people in advance of a boarding arrangement being made.

Client understands that dogs, as animals, are unpredictable and, without warning, may bite or cause harm to others, even with no prior occurances. Client understands that there are risks involved in daycare and boarding settings such as fights, bites, and the potential for the transmission of diseases and releases Highland Hollow LLC of liability.

If a pet is found to be aggressive or display behavioral problems while in group play, the pet will no longer will allowed to participate in group play. Client agrees to be solely responsible for any harm caused by their dog to any employees, other dogs/owners, and/or property. Client agrees to reimburse Highland Hollow LLC for all costs (including, but not limited to, medical care and lost wages) associated with exposure to dog(s). Highland Hollow LLC reserves the right to terminate service due to safety concerns, financial concerns, or inappropriate or uncomfortable situations.

If while boarding pet becomes ill or injured and client cannot be immediately reached, client authorizes Paws & Play to seek veterinary services. Client is responsible for any charges that may

occur from veterinary services.

Client acknowledges that Paws & Play may use photos taken of client's pet(s) during their boarding stay on social media.
